# **Circus Rigger Application Pack**



# Summary

Mimbre seeks an experienced Circus Rigger to work with us on the creation and tour of Mimbre's new production, *The Exploded Circus*. It is a freelance role over various dates from 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018 until November 2018.

The Exploded Circus will tour with a self-standing rig to theatre venues and found spaces as well as two performance weeks in a hired circus tent. The rigger is a key role within the team, initially being involved in ideas for design and use of the rig and equipment within it, then going on to be responsible for all rigging and safety of equipment within the set. The range of aerial skills will encompass silks, dance trapeze, slack wire, hoop amongst others.

Flexibility and an ability to problem-solve is essential for this unusual and exciting production and we are seeking someone who enjoys working collaboratively and has experience of working with weight-bearing sets.

## Key Tasks and Responsibilities (this list is not exhaustive):

- Creatively contributing ideas for the design, build and use of the rig during construction and rehearsal periods
- Installing and checking all performer and equipment rigging during rehearsals, tour and performances
- Regular inspections of the rig and equipment for safety / damage and organising repair and upkeep of all rigging materials as necessary
- Alongside the Technical Stage Manager, lead on the build and strike of the rig at each venue on the tour
- Sharing the driving of van on tour
- Working with the Technical Stage Manager and the wider company to develop and maintain a safe working environment at all times

## Skills and Experience

The role still has some flexibility to be built around the experience of the right person, so this list is indicative:

- 2+ years' experience in circus rigging / proven experience in a similar role
- Ability to think creatively and problem-solve
- Ability to work as part of the team
- Ability to work under pressure calmly and efficiently
- Clean driving licence
- An adequate understanding of legislation relevant to circus and performance
  - Working at Height

- Manual Handling
- Health and Safety Legislation

#### Desirable

- Experience touring to venues as well as festival / found spaces
- Experience in technical theatre lighting and/or sound
- First Aid Qualification
- Clean driving licence up to 7.5 tonne vehicle

The roles of Technical Stage Manager and Technical Operator are also being recruited to create a strong touring team, alongside a cast of six performers.

Mimbre is used to working with a small team where everyone gets involved including performers and gives a hand where needed, so we are looking for a person who is happy to work in a pro-active collaborative way and have flexibility in their role.

A positive outward facing attitude and good people skills to work in unusual settings is essential. In exchange you will be working with a supportive team and on an exciting artistic project.

# About The Exploded Circus

The Exploded Circus is an all-female contemporary circus production with a highly visual narrative that uses the scene of a devastated circus and its performers as an allegory to explore what we perceive as society and how we might rebuild it were our world to collapse.

The show invites audiences into a moment where an explosion has been frozen in time, the remnants of a circus caught mid-air - with everything from the circus ring, sequins, and fairground horses suspended above the ground. Featuring acrobatics, aerial work, juggling and other specialist skills the performance weave a physical story told without words; where six circus performers have to find their own order in the chaos and create a new normal, exploring themes around change, belonging, community, and what being human means to us.

A purpose made, self-standing rig will be created for the performance and the design integrated into the rig – allowing the show to be toured to venues who don't normally have possibilities for circus rigging. The tour includes theatres, an old town-hall, an old fruit market as well as two weeks in a circus tent.

The tour will include audience development elements such as open rehearsals, workshops and post-show events.
